



WaterWorks Museum - Field Trip Guidelines

- Tours are offered Monday-Friday between 9:00am and 2:00pm.
- The experience will take approximately 2 hours.
- Admission is \$3.00 per child, \$5.00 per chaperone, teachers are free.
- Location is 3005 River Road, 40207

- Schools/Camps arrange and provide their own transportation.
- Louisville Water prefers one adult chaperone per every 10 students. Teachers and/or group leaders are responsible for students while visiting.
- A portion of the experience is outdoors and some walking is required, please dress appropriately. Comfortable walking shoes are a must. In the case of severe or inclement weather tours may have to be cancelled and/or rescheduled.
- Minimum of 12 students. Maximum of 60 students per tour-for larger groups please talk with staff when making your reservation to see if there are any alternate options.
- Students must be at least 6 years old to tour some facilities. Age regulations are required due to safety. You may bring younger children but they will not be allowed inside the working pumping station and must be chaperoned while they wait for other participants to tour.
- No indoor facility access for lunch---can use outdoor grounds area, weather permitting. Schools/groups are responsible for all clean up. There are also 2 parks with picnic areas less than ¼ mile from LWTP.
- Please let us know in advance if you have participants with special needs or requirements.
- No photography is allowed inside the working pump stations.
- There is a retail area on site with a range of Water Tower merchandise.
- Restrooms available.
