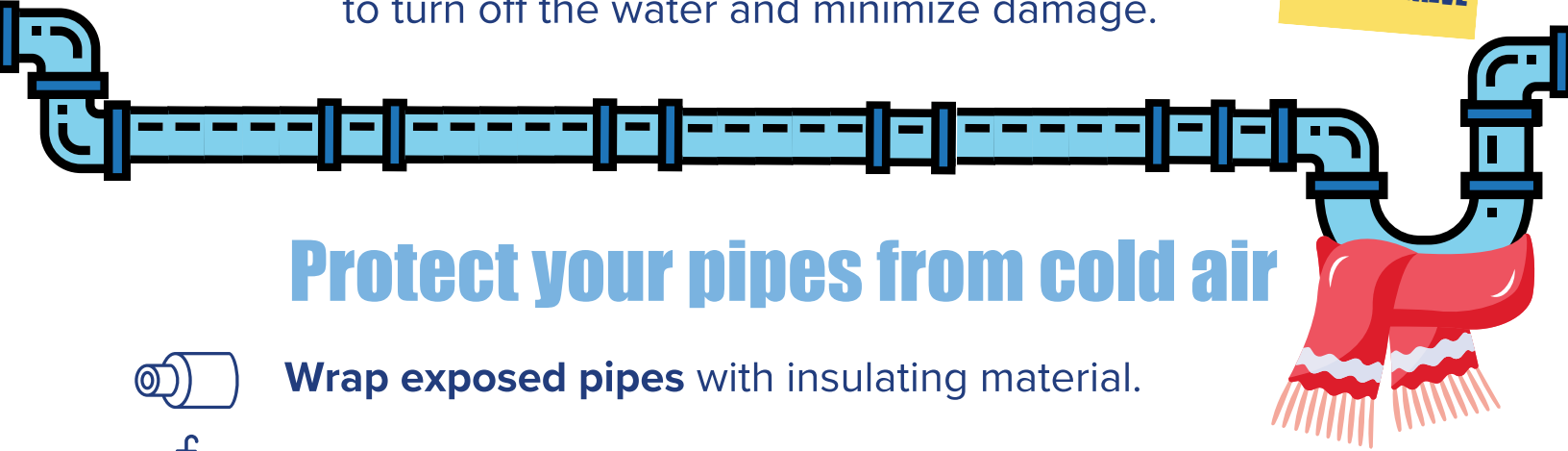


Protect your pipes and your home

Find your shutoff valve and tag it

If a pipe bursts in cold weather, use your shutoff valve to turn off the water and minimize damage.



Protect your pipes from cold air



Wrap exposed pipes with insulating material.



Open cabinet doors to allow heat to circulate around the pipes.



If your home has a crawl space, cover the outside vents.



If your house has a slab foundation, close the garage door.



Run a small trickle of water from a cold-water faucet where pipes are either exposed or have a history of freezing.
